Admission Requirements



☐ General Requirements:

A Master's degree (or equivalent qualification) from a recognised university; or a Bachelor's degree with first-class honours from a recognised university.



☐ English Language Requirements:

- IELTS: Overall score of IELTS 6.5 with no subtest lower than 6.0; or
- TOEFL: TOEFL score of 80 (internet-based test); or
- IELTS/TOEFL is <u>not required</u> if the prior degree was taught and assessed in English
