Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) programme

➤ **Study Period (full-time; 3 or 4 years)**

3 years: Master's degree by Research

4 years: Master's degree not by Research or Bachelor's degree
with first-class honours

➤ **Tuition Fee:**

Charged within the Normal Study Period : HK\$42,100 (~US\$5,300) per annum

FOLIO*

- Three or more publications
- SCI listed journals
- Candidates must be the **first author** in all publications

[Note: Upon endorsement by supervisors, students could apply for the **'Cross-institutional Course Enrolment Scheme'** and enroll in courses offered by sister institutions (course fees will not be charged). Credit exemption could be granted for successfully completing a cross-institutional course.]

Admission Requirements



□ General Requirements:


A Master's degree (or equivalent qualification) from a recognised university; or a Bachelor's degree with first-class honours from a recognised university.



□ English Language Requirements:

- **IELTS:** Overall score of **IELTS 6.5** with no subtest lower than 6.0; or
- **TOEFL:** **TOEFL score of 80** (internet-based test); or
- IELTS/TOEFL is not required if the prior degree was taught and assessed in English
